

Call for Student Posters

Share your research with the public, and possibly win a prize

The 2015 **World Science Fiction Convention** (www.sasquan.org) is looking for **high school student, undergraduate student, graduate student or post-doctoral scholar** to participate in its **Super Science Saturday** event. The convention will be at the **Spokane, WA Convention Center** on Aug. 19-23, 2015. Saturday programming will have a special focus on science, including talks, exhibits and demonstrations. There will be a **\$100 prize** for the poster that **best communicates science to the general public**.

Poster Session

Here is an opportunity to share your research with an audience that is very interested in sciences, engineering and technology. The poster session will run from 10 AM to 5 PM on Saturday, Aug. 22nd (set-up beginning at 9 AM), and we ask that you be at your poster from 12-2 to answer questions and meet the fans.

Poster Format

The poster should be no more than 4 ft. wide. If it is more than 4 ft. tall, plan to have something to weigh-down the bottom edge as it will be hanging off the bottom of the poster stand. Since the poster should be aimed at a general audience, **DO NOT** simply recycle a poster from a professional meeting.

Entry and Registration

To participate, send an email to Sam Scheiner (posters@sasquan.org) **no later than July 1**. Please include your name, your academic affiliation, the poster title, and an abstract of no more than 100 words. Note that participation requires that you be a registered member of the convention. There will be a special one-day rate for participants of **\$25**.
